In the event you are absent, **please check Google Classroom for the work to complete so that we do not fall behind** - you have all of the materials you need to complete the work for our next class.

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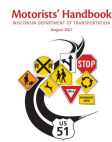
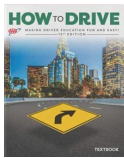
**COVID policy/procedures** - We are following Elkhorn Area School District's policies for symptoms and exposure as well as the need for quarantine (not attend class) if required.

### **Written DMV tests**

Students will be taking 2 written DMV tests for their permit during class rather than at the DMV.

### **MV-3001 form**

With the successful completion of this course, this form will be handed out at the parent meeting on the last day of class. You are required to take this form to the

DMV to obtain the learner's permit. If you are planning to drive with CESA2, please be sure your student is registered and paid in order to obtain this form.

### **Behind the Wheel:**

- When your student turns 15 and you have successfully completed this course, you can take the MV-3001 form to the DMV to obtain the learner's permit.
  - Once you have the permit, contact me as soon as possible ([joann.struwe@cesa2.org](mailto:joann.struwe@cesa2.org)) so that we can schedule behind the wheel lessons.
  - Students are required to be 16 years old, hold their permit for at least 6 months and complete all behind the wheel lessons before going to the DMV to get their probationary license.
  - DMV road test: All students must schedule the road test with the DMV. The waiver is no longer an option.
  - Scheduling behind the wheel: Once you have the permit in hand, I will collect the permit number from you and email you a list of openings to choose from. To meet the state requirements, we will schedule 6 lessons, 2 hours each (1 hour driving and 1 hour observing another student).
  - 48 hour policy
    - I understand that life happens, but it is very important to schedule dates that you can commit to. I am not allowed to drive with 1 student. If you cancel without enough notice and/or do not show up for a lesson, the student who was scheduled to drive with you also has to reschedule. This may significantly delay you and the other student in completing behind the wheel.
